

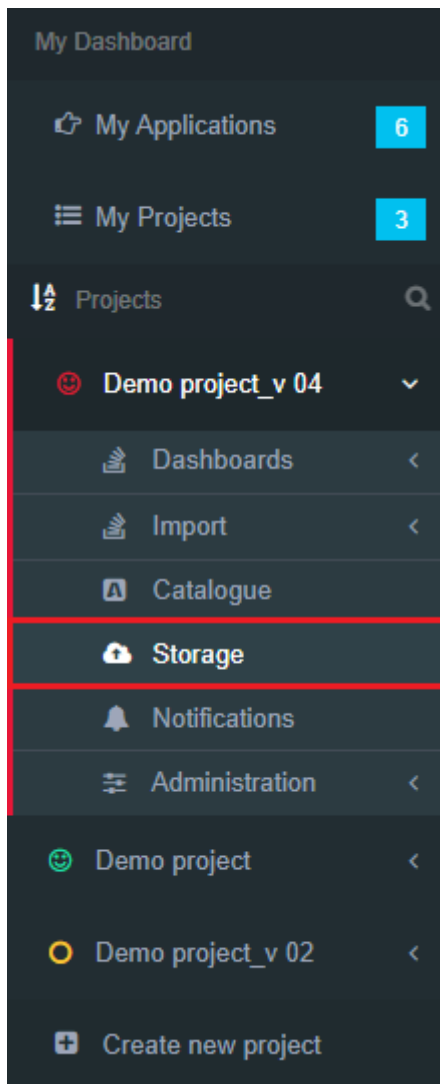
Storage
